Maple Tubing Collection Program

Solid Waste Districts throughout Vermont, along with the Vermont Agency of Agriculture have begun a maple sap line recycling program. This program will allow all Vermont producers of maple syrup to bring their expired sap lines to district locations throughout Vermont. This program will help to divert these materials from our waste stream.

The Northwest Solid Waste District has been collecting maple tubing since Jan 15th, 2011 at our location in Georgia. Contact your local districts for details about their collection program.

2. Tee's / Taps / Fittings are fine / **NO PVC Fitting**
3. Remove all debris example: tension wire / strapping / leaves and dirt
4. No Drainage or Sewer / Water Service line

| 2. Stake – Body Truck | - | \$ 35.00 / load |
| 3. Grain or Dump Truck | - | \$ 70.00 / load |
