ORDINANCE TOWN OF FRANKLIN


NOTICE

TO ALL OPERATORS AND OWNERS OF SNOWMOBILES AND ALL-TERRAIN  
VEHICLES IN THE TOWN OF FRANKLIN, VERMONT

All snowmobiles and all-terrain vehicles shall be registered and operated in accordance with the Vermont Laws pertaining to the regulation and operation of such snowmobiles and all-terrain vehicles as set forth in Vermont Statutes Annotated, Title 23, Chapter 29, Section 3206-3212 and Title 23, Chapter 31, Section 3501-3512. And such snowmobiles and all-terrain vehicles shall further be controlled in operation by the order of the Selectmen of the Town of Franklin, as follows:

1. Snowmobiles and All-Terrain Vehicles shall not be operated in or near residential areas after 10:00 P.M.
2. Snowmobiles and All-Terrain Vehicles shall not be operated on the sidewalks in the Village of Franklin.
3. Written permission must be obtained from all landowners on whose property Snowmobiles and All-Terrain Vehicles are being operated.
4. All Franklin Town Roads are open to use by Snowmobiles and All-Terrain Vehicles. ROUTE 120 - the NORTH SHELDON - LAKE CARMEL highway is closed by order of the State of Vermont. This means also the MAIN STREET of Franklin Center. Also ROUTE 236 - the STATE PARK highway is closed by order of the State of Vermont.
5. The above regulations shall be enforced.
6. Penalties for not complying with the above ordinances and laws shall be in accordance with Laws and regulations governing the use and registration of snowmobiles and all-terrain vehicles in the State of Vermont.
7. Books regarding use and regulations of snowmobiles and all-terrain vehicles are printed by the Department of Motor Vehicles and distributed by the State Police.
8. Should these regulations not properly control snowmobiles and all-terrain vehicles to the satisfaction of those in authority, at the discretion of the Selectmen of the Town of Franklin, these rules and regulations shall be changed.

The above rules and regulations are in effect until further notice.




TO ALL OPERATORS AND OWNERS OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES:


In accordance with the Town Ordinance dated May 7, 1985 - Article 8 - the following change has been made:


Until further notice ALL STREETS within the limits of FRANKLIN VILLAGE (ie MAIN STREET, from the Clark Hubbard Home Farm to the Ronald Meunier Farm; SCHOOL STREET, SQUARE ROAD, HIGHGATE STREET passed the Thomas Magnant Farm) are now CLOSED to All-Terrain Vehicles.


