

## Town of Franklin – Driveway Culvert Policy

Adopted June 26, 2017

### Purpose:

The purpose of an accepted driveway culvert policy is to define the scope of procedures for the Highway Crew relating to residential driveway culverts. New driveways require a permit and approval from the Town Selectboard and Highway Foreman.

### Procedure:


The property owner is responsible for purchase and proper installation of their first driveway culvert upon approval of a driveway permit. The new driveway must be inspected and approved by the Highway Foreman after construction. The highway crew will monitor individual residential driveway culverts for proper function; or upon the request of the resident to inspect a failed driveway culvert. If deemed failed by the Highway Foreman the town will be responsible for replacement or repair of one primary residential driveway culvert per property.

### Materials:

The town will replace with the proper sized culvert to meet State and Town road standards and gravel as needed.


