Yvon Dandurand called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The Pledge of allegiance was said.

**Dog Complaints:** Two complaints have been submitted regarding Norm Kern's dogs running free and being on their properties causing a nuisance. Town Clerk will do a letter advising dogs must be kept on own property and issue a warning ticket. A complaint has been received regarding Tanner Abbott at 5102 Main Street; dogs running free and unleashed/tied causing damage to others animals and being aggressive toward residence. Town Clerk will send a letter about the village leash law and registering the dogs; a warning ticket will also be issued.

**Road Commissioner:** Kyle Lothian has submitted a letter of resignation as Road Commissioner affective November 13<sup>th</sup>. Yvon respectfully accepts Kyle's resignation. Kyle/Yvon make to motion to appoint Andy Godin as Road Commissioner until town meeting. All members voted in favor.

**Highway Crew:** Need to review the personal policy regarding vacation time being taken at the same time for both crew members. Concerns over authority of road foreman continue.

**Sand shed project:** Heath Wright as inquired about getting paid for the excavation work/drainage that was done for the sand shed. Board members have reviewed the site and agree that all looks good; would like Wayne to do a final inspection. Send Heath his check and Wayne will do a final inspection when back in town.

**Budget review:** The board reviewed the budget by line item for the 2014-2015 budget. Would like to include a separate article again for the Sheriff coverage next year and a note of what was returned in fines to the town to offset the costs paid. The Town Clerk will speak with Alisha Sawyer, Watershed Coordinator, regarding petitioning for their requested funding for next year. Kyle suggests speaking with Whitcom regarding hiring/rental of a larger grader for the first grade of the year. Lisa will put together the preliminary budget for the next meeting for further review.

Kyle/Yvon made a motion to adjourn the meeting. All members voted in favor, motion passed. Meeting adjourned at 8:22 p.m.
