Municipal Planning Grant:

State Highway Budget:

VLCT has sent to all Selectboards a Resolution "Opposing the large cuts to the State Highway funds" which would in turn cut the available funds the towns would receive for their state aid to highway reflecting an increase to our local taxes for highway maintenance. VLCT is trying to advocate the legislature on behalf of the towns. After discussion, Lynn/Jamie made motion to accept and sign the Resolution. All in favor

Park & Ride Grant:

Scott read the letter from Hugh Gates. Gilbert Dewing addressed the board on how the Homestead Board feels about the project. Mr. Dewing stated that the Homestead Board agrees with the project.

Hugh Gates entered the meeting at 7:45. Hugh reiterated that Franklin Telephone does not go along with the Park & Ride project.

After discussion, Peter stated the board needs to find out about the Right-of-Way and what the town can do with it.

Boston Post Rd:

The Board talked about the gate which is located at the end of the Boston Post Rd and is locked. Peter will look into the issue.

Jamie/Harvey made the motion to adjourn at 8:50. All in favor
